PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The PAEC Technology Leadership Academy is a one-year program designed to facilitate School District Staff becoming Certified Educational Technology Leaders. Participants will work to increase skills and knowledge in the following COSN CETL areas:

- Understanding the Educational Environment
- Managing Technology & Support Resources
- Core Values & Skills

KEY GOALS

Successful completion of the PAEC Technology Leadership Academy will prepare participants to pass the Consortium of School Networking (CoSN) Certified Educational Technology Leader (CETL) Certification Exam

OBJECTIVES

- Provide participants with skills and knowledge needed to effectively develop Leadership and Vision
- Develop participants' understanding of the strategic planning process.
- Increase knowledge and skills in the areas of Ethics and Policies
- Provide foundational knowledge and skills for the development of effective professional learning activities
- Develop skills necessary for quality team building and staffing
- Increase the participant's ability to build relationships with stakeholders
- Share best practices to increase the participant's ability to direct, coordinate and ensure implementation of all tasks related to technology operations.

**** Requirements****

Must have a Bachelors Degree plus four years of education technology experience. Education technology experience is defined as demonstrable experience in the three overarching skill areas of:

- **Leadership and Vision**
- **Understanding the Educational Environment**
- **Managing Technology and Support Resources**

If candidates do not meet the minimum education requirements, they must have at least seven years of demonstrable experience. To be deemed eligible using these criteria, candidates must appeal in writing to the Certification Governance Committee (CGC) with an explanation of their experience.
